Dear Kingfisher families,

As you are aware, we are working in partnership with Contract Dining to provide healthy and nutritious meals for our children. I would just like to draw your attention to a few of their policies and keep you informed of what they can deliver.

All children in FS2, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for a universal free school meal. Contract Dining provide a hot main meal, jacket potatoes with a choice of filling and baguette bar with a choice of fillings. There is also a daily salad bar and a choice of puddings. If your child currently brings a packed lunch and they are in FS2, Year 1 and Year 2, you may want to encourage them to try a baguette or a hot meal.

In term 3 the kitchen will also be offering taster pots of the main meal for any child who brings in a packed lunch so that they can try the meals on offer if they would like.

If children are in Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) children's meals are charged at £1.92 per day. Thank you all for your diligence in keeping up to date with payments.

It has been suggested by Contract Dining, that if payment has not been received after two meals, that you provide a packed lunch for your child until the debt is paid.

We understand the pressure this puts on families so to support this, please link up to Schools Food United <https://parents.schoolfoodunited.com/login> so that you can see any balance due, are able to pay for meals and can see what is on offer in the menu. In addition, Contract Dining can further support you through Schools Food United so it is vital that you link up to this system if your child is having a school dinner. If you need help accessing the site please contact the school office who will be happy to assist you.

Children from FS2- Year 6 may also be entitled to free school meals. If you feel your child may be eligible, or simply want to know the criteria, please speak to the office and we will support you with the process.

Lisa and Sasha, our school cooks, do a wonderful job of keeping the children happy and fed. The meals on offer are all delicious and popular with members of staff and visitors.
